The reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the Romans 2:10-16

Brethren, glory and honor and peace for every one who does good, the Jew first and also the Greek. For God shows no partiality. All who have sinned without the law will also perish without the law, and all who have sinned under the law will be judged by the law. For it is not the hearers of the law who are righteous before God, but the doers of the law who will be justified. When Gentiles who have not the law do by nature what the law requires, they are a law to themselves, even though they do not have the law. Continuation of the Principals of Orthodox Stewardship:

3. Sound, courages, stewardship programs will challenge the status quo of flawed Church structures and practices,

Among the issues for consideration would be a review of the fundamental roles of lay and clergy leaders and the shortcomings of common lay Parish Board (vs. episcopal/clerical leadership) structures and the membership dues system. Pastoral prudence is necessary in such cases, where embedded practices are sometimes 'enshrined' and without a strong catechesis beforehand, upsetting the status quo may cause serious distrust on many levels in parish life. In communities where parish life is self-oriented, a new outward looking orientation will need to be presented.

We as Orthodox Christians see stewardship more of as a part of of a greater whole of Christian life, than a topic unto itself. Orthodox stewardship must be illuminated not only by its biblical roots, but by other detentions of Holy Tradition as well, so that it is not simply and appendage (albeit interesting) to Christian life, but a component part.
